The North Macomb Sportsmen's Club will conduct a Hunters Education Program on Saturday, August 27 and Sunday August 28, 2011 for the open public youth and adults seeking Michigan Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Safe Hunter Certification.

To purchase a hunting license to participate in Michigan's 2011-12 hunting seasons, all first-time hunters ages 12 and up, or any prospective hunter born after January 1, 1960 who cannot show possession of a previous hunting license, must take and successfully complete this course to earn a Michigan DNR Safe Hunter Certificate.

This program will consist of two days of classes, rain or shine. On Saturday, registration begins at **8:00 AM, and classes run from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM.** Sunday's check in is at **11:00 AM**, program commences at **11:30 AM and concludes at 4:30 PM** with award of a Michigan DNR Safe Hunter Certificate and shoulder patch to every participant who attends every class and successfully completes a DNR provided examination at the end of the class sessions. Modules will cover firearms safety, hunter safety and responsibility, black powder, archery basics, first aid, survival, rifle and shotgun marksmanship, wildlife identification, wildlife conservation, and hunters' ethics and responsibilities. Students will handle and fire rifles and shotguns during the course of instruction.

All instructors have been certified by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and are NRA recognized.

A \$5.00 fee is charged to cover the costs of the Michigan Safe Hunter shoulder patch, range fees, and ammunition. Each student will receive a safe hunter's booklet, paid for by Pittman-Robertson Act taxes upon firearms and ammunition. Special assistance will be available reading or hearing impaired.

Participants will be required to bring a lunch on Saturday, the 27th. Soda will be provided and a Walk-in cooler is available for storage of lunches.

Those who wish to attend and participate must submit a completely executed application either electronically or manually
